Mr. McAvoy,
Thank you for your email. The legislative changes to the Companies Creditors Arrangement Act (CCAA) that gave the Office of the Superintendent of Bankruptcy (OSB) the power to receive complaints regarding, and make investigations with respect to, the conduct of monitors came into force on September 18, 2009. The proceedings under the CCAA for Nortel Networks Corporation (Nortel) commenced on January 14, 2009 under a previous version of the CCAA that did not include these amendments. It is this latter version of the CCAA that governs the Nortel proceedings and not the post-September 18, 2009 legislation in force today. Accordingly, the OSB has no authority to involve itself in any capacity whatsoever in the Nortel CCAA proceedings. Stakeholders like yourself still have recourse to the court however and you should retain competent legal counsel if you wish to explore your options in this regard.
