James Girling, Marilyn Marshall, Phil Simeon, Barbara Duckitt:

I wrote the attached letter to Assistant Deputy Minister Frank Denton, since he appointed himself to be the Director under the Ontario Consumer Protection Act accountable for his decision not to complete an investigation of the Complaint on the Unfair Business Practices and Misrepresentation on Disability Insurance Supplied by Nortel and Sun Life to Nortel disabled former employees. However, my message applies to the four of you too, since you have been involved in making this decision. The three lawyers involved in this decision have not refuted the legal arguments of Joel Rochon in his letter of August 16, 2011, nor did they provide any legal arguments or cases of their own to support no jurisdiction for the Act to complete the requested investigation.

I would like all of you to read Governor General David Johnston's Speech to the Canadian Bar Association 2011 Canadian Legal Conference at the link below. Please reflect upon whether the government lawyers involved in this decision to date are serving justice and the public good. Or, are the government lawyers serving their own interests to cover for the bankruptcy lawyers' and judges' systemic failure to protect disability insurance assets in the trust for the Nortel disabled as described in the research report at the link below.
